Activity

◎Local Environmental Maintenance and Conservation Project

- Weeding of other public places, etc.

◎Mobility Support Project for People with Mobility Difficulties

- Free bus service for local residents
- Lending project of electric small mobility, etc.

◎Promotion of Community Development Project

- Promotion of volunteer activities for the community, including support for the lives of the elderly, etc.
- Promotion of collaborative projects and communications with other organizations that work for the community (beach cleaning, etc.)

- Operation of the supporters system and solicitation of donations such as the Gojo seal project
- Preparation and delivery of newsletters
- Public relations and PR activities of the corps
- Other projects related to community development, etc.

◎Wholesome Development and Communication Programs for Young People

- Promotion of wholesome development projects for young people (summer vacation radio gymnastics, cultivation and tree-planting activities, etc.)
- Communication programs for local residents and support for festivals such as Bon Odori festivals led by Miyayama Ward

- Deposit and withdrawal operations and management based on budget plans
- Collection and distribution of paid volunteer works, etc.
